The scholarship will achieve this mission by assisting students in financing their first year of college.

Criteria:

- Open to graduating seniors from Aspen, Basalt, Roaring Fork, and Glenwood Springs H.S.
- Must demonstrate financial need
- Plan to attend an accredited two-year or four-year secular college or university
- Enroll full time at college or university
- Be the first generation in their families to attend college (having siblings in college will not preclude students from the scholarship)

Required Application Materials:

- Completed application form
- Personal essay
- Official school transcripts of grades
- FAFSA Student Aid Report
- Two letters of recommendation
- Resume
- An interview may be required for finalists
