ACF Scholarship & Eligibility Requirements:

- This scholarship provides \$4,595 per accepted student to cover the full tuition cost of \$5,795. If accepted, students will pay \$1,200 to ACF for their portion of the tuition cost to join either June 25-July 5th or July 1-11th 2025 tour dates.
- All students must be 15 years or older by July 1, 2025
- Be a current 10th or 11th grade student at Basalt, Roaring Fork, Bridges, Yampah Mountain, Glenwood Springs, Coal Ridge or Rifle high schools.
- All students must have a valid passport for international travel.
- All students are expected to fulfill post-trip requirements as scholarship recipients.
