WRM COAD

ACF founded the West Mountain Regional Community Organizations Active in Disaster (COAD) in 2022 after a series of convenings of more than 40 nonprofit organizations, government agencies and emergency managers explored the role of community-based organizations during disaster response. Since its founding, COAD has helped community organizations respond more effectively to disasters in Pitkin, Eagle and Garfield counties.

The COAD brings together nonprofit, faith-based, voluntary and government organizations to foster a more effective response to disaster-related needs during "blue sky" conditions. The goal is to organize and deploy community resources efficiently, thus enhancing the community's ability to mitigate, prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from disasters.

As an umbrella organization, COAD connects organizations that provide aid to emergency responders, government agencies and community members in times of disasters. Each organization maintains its identity and independence, yet works closely with others to improve service, maximize resources and eliminate unnecessary duplication of efforts. **COAD is led by a steering committee that includes representatives from:**

The work of the COAD includes:

- · Recruiting, training and deploying volunteers
- Receiving and distributing donations such as food, water and supplies
- · Accepting and disbursing monetary donations
- Pushing out updated information during a disaster event and educating the community about disaster preparedness
- Coordinating long-term recovery efforts

In 2024, the COAD focused on recruiting and training volunteers, strengthening relationships with county emergency managers, and establishing donation hubs throughout the three counties.



YOUTH IN NATURE

The 2024-2025 school year was the third season of the Youth in Nature (YIN) program—an ACF communityled initiative developed in collaboration with nonprofit partners and funded by the Jonathan D + Mark C. Lewis Foundation (JDMCLF).

Partners include Roaring Fork Outdoor Volunteers (RFOV/lead partner), Aspen Center for Environmental Sciences, Farm Collaborative, Aspen Valley Land Trust, Buddy Program, and Aspen One.

YIN is a year-long empowerment and education program that motivates high school students from across the Parachute to Aspen region to get outside. It combines elements of nature, mental and physical health, stewardship, and community building. The program connects participants with new people, places, and outdoor professionals. Every year, between June and May, twelve students participate in YIN's orientation, wilderness hut trip and nine thematic weekend sessions. School year sessions feature stewardship projects, outdoor recreation and skills development and introduce students to the diverse work of nonprofit partners and the inspiring landscapes of the Roaring Fork and Colorado River Valleys.

Designed to introduce outdoor career paths and strengthen confidence, students are encouraged to have new experiences to step outside their comfort zone. Students are invited to continue their involvement with partners via internships, volunteerism and participation in their core programs. The upcoming program season will offer expanded opportunities for YIN graduates to return and continue their involvement through alumni gatherings and stewardship projects.

Since its inception in 2022 with support from JDMCLF grants, YIN is offered at no cost to students and provides transportation, gear and an award they can use for educational expenses. The 2024-25 season marked the conclusion of Youth in Nature's three-year pilot phase. The program fully transitions to YIN's lead partner in 2025 and will be integrated into RFOV's core program offerings. YIN's fourth year launches in June 2025 with a new cohort of high school students from across the region.





Total Assets by Fund





