ACF Scholarship & Eligibility Requirements:

- **Applications are due by January 23, 2026.** You will be notified in February 2026 if you have been accepted for a scholarship.
- The scholarship will cover 80% (\$4,695) of the total cost of tuition \$5,895. Approved students are required to pay \$1,200 to ACF for your portion of tuition.
- Eligible High Schools: Aspen, Basalt, Roaring Fork, Bridges, Yampah Mountain, Glenwood Springs, Coal Ridge, Rifle and Grand Valley H.S.
- Be a current 10th or 11th grade student who is passionate about history and WWII and mature enough to travel internationally with adults who are not their parents or own teachers. Students must be 16 years of age by June 24, 2026.
- All students must have a valid passport for international travel.
- All students are expected to fulfill ACF's post-trip requirements
