Aspen Community Foundation (ACF) invests in a future where everyone from Aspen to Parachute has equitable opportunities to thrive. Our region is geographically, racially, and culturally diverse and rich in opportunity for the individuals and families who call it home.



To ensure this potential is accessible to all, we actively listen and learn about the region's challenges, connect nonprofit, philanthropic, and community leaders advancing solutions, and partner with donors and funders to catalyze community-led change in the areas of early childhood, youth empowerment, and community leadership.

To the Community

In 2025, we were reminded of what is possible when communities come together to shape their future.

Across our region, people stepped forward to address immediate challenges while investing in long-term solutions. Donors responded generously to urgent needs, supporting residents in mobile home communities and strengthening access to food and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits for families facing economic pressures.

We also celebrated a historic milestone with the passage of Ballot Measure 7A, creating the Confluence Early Childhood Development Service District. Years of collaboration, advocacy, and community engagement culminated in a powerful investment in young children, families, and our region's future. Through our longstanding partnership with Confluence Early Childhood Education Coalition (CECE), ACF and coalition members united community leaders, educators,

families, and funders around a shared vision. That sustained commitment, grounded in years of collaboration, advocacy, and community engagement, has led to a powerful investment in young children, families, and our region's future.

Just as importantly, we continued creating opportunities for learning and dialogue. Through educational events such as a community screening of "UnCharitable" and 21/64's Values in Philanthropy training, donors and community members explored new ways to think about generosity, impact, and the role philanthropy can play in addressing complex challenges.

Young people also demonstrated the impact of community leadership. The Teen Giving Circle raised and distributed \$30,000 to local nonprofits, showing that philanthropy and civic engagement begins at any age. Momentum also continued to build through the Youth Empowerment Alliance, where young people shape conversations about

opportunities and challenges facing our communities. Their voices guide the work ahead and lay the foundation for even greater impact in the years to come.

These accomplishments share a common thread: lasting change happens when people participate, lead, and work together.

As Aspen Community Foundation looks toward 2026, we will deepen our focus on supporting community leadership, building nonprofit capacity, and connecting donors with the people, ideas, and solutions that shape a stronger future for our region.

Thank you to our donors, nonprofit partners, volunteers, and community members whose generosity and commitment make this work possible. Together, we create opportunities that will benefit our region for generations to come.

Nonprofit Center of Excellence

In 2025, Aspen Community Foundation introduced the Nonprofit Center of Excellence (NCE), a regional resource that supports nonprofit organizations throughout the Aspen to Parachute region, enabling them to recognize and actualize their full potential in delivering positive, sustainable community impact. We've partnered with Human Service Innovations to facilitate the delivery of a series of professional learning and development opportunities to strengthen the competencies and capacity of local nonprofit leaders and their teams. The Nonprofit Center of Excellence provides year-round professional development and capacity-building workshops, led by experienced professionals that serve as "NCE Faculty," offering valuable tools and techniques that optimize mission delivery and impact.

Nonprofit Center for Excellence Academy (NCEA)

Debuting on June 2, 2025, the NCEA was a remarkable success. Delivered as a five-day conference, the Academy included 16 local nonprofits and reached over 40 participants representing operational and board leaders through an intensive learning and development experience.



The NCEA was designed to provide a comprehensive entry-level overview of critical leadership and operational functions essential to the success of a nonprofit organization.

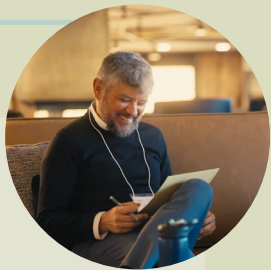

Outcome Highlights



100%
of respondents **strongly agreed** that the content provided was relevant to their organization's needs.

93%
indicated that they are **very likely** to apply strategies and practices learned during the academy.

The NCEA provided a unique, never-before-offered experience for nonprofit leaders at both the operations and governance levels of the organization. The NCEA achieved its intended purpose of helping leaders identify the strengths and gaps within their organization and build peer and professional relationships to support them in achieving greater and more sustainable mission impact. The NCEA set the stage for organizations to put the critical foundations in place, and where appropriate, prepare to go deeper, bigger and more boldly forward in their work.

For the Aspen to Parachute region, the NCEA brought new energy and expertise to the important work of the nonprofit sector. It provided practical and accessible support that has ignited action to achieve greater community impact and should no doubt inspire confidence in the philanthropic community's investment in our regional nonprofit ecosystem.

Youth Empowerment Alliance & EMPOWER

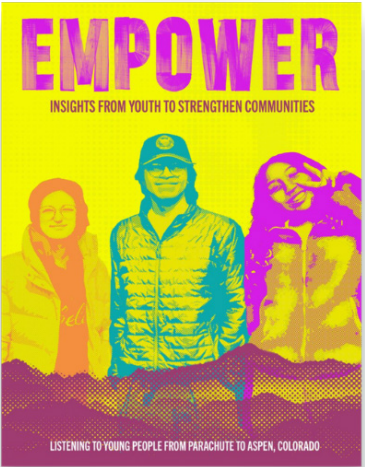
EMPOWER is a digital report that amplifies the voices of young people from Parachute to Aspen, Colorado. It emerged from the Youth Empowerment Alliance (YEA/the Alliance), a coalition of 21 youth-serving nonprofit organizations and youth leaders from the Roaring Fork and Colorado River valleys that gathered throughout 2024 to learn together and collaborate.

The Jonathan D + Mark C. Lewis Foundation funded this work and partnered with ACF to support the YEA process and the nonprofit and youth leaders who guided it. During gatherings, one message became clear—**young people have much to say and want their voices heard.**

1,200 youth ages 12–18, from Parachute to Aspen, participated in surveys, interviews, and focus groups initiated by the Alliance February-May of 2025.

EMPOWER shares what was learned from young people, and highlights their experiences, the opportunities that inspire them, and the barriers they face.

EMPOWER is an important step toward listening more deeply and learning directly from young people in our communities. Their insights offer important guidance for organizations, schools, municipalities, and funders working to expand opportunities for youth across the region.

A Lasting Investment in Young Children

In November 2025, voters across the Parachute to Aspen region approved the creation of the Confluence Early Childhood Development Service District, establishing a permanent source of local funding to support young children and families for generations to come.

For Aspen Community Foundation, this milestone represents the culmination of more than a decade of leadership, partnership, and community-driven problem solving.

The journey began in 2017 through ACF's Cradle to Career Initiative, which identified early childhood development and education as a critical factor in long-term educational success. What followed was nine years of research, coalition building, policy innovation, community engagement, and advocacy. Along the way, hundreds of community members, early childhood professionals, business leaders, educators, elected officials, and philanthropic partners helped shape a vision for a stronger early childhood system serving families from Aspen to Parachute.

The result is transformative. The new district will generate dedicated funding to expand access to child care and preschool, strengthen the early childhood workforce, support providers, and help ensure that every child has the opportunity to thrive before entering kindergarten.

The success of this effort reflects the power of sustained investment and collective action. It required patience, persistence, and a willingness to tackle complex challenges through collaboration. Aspen Community Foundation was proud to serve as a convener, funder, and trusted community partner throughout the process, working alongside organizations including MANAUS, Aspen One, school districts, child care providers, parents, and countless local leaders.

The Confluence Early Childhood Development Service District stands as a powerful example of what is possible when a community comes together around a shared vision. Thanks to the dedication of so many partners and supporters, children and families across our region will benefit from this investment for years.

ACF Regional Rise Fund

Officially launched in 2025, Aspen Community Foundation's Regional Rise Fund is the organization's first impact investing fund, created in partnership with First Southwest Community Fund to expand access to affordable capital for small businesses and nonprofits from Aspen to Parachute.

As part of ACF's broader impact-first investing strategy, the fund helps address critical financing gaps by providing loans ranging from \$10,000 to \$50,000 with flexible terms for working capital, equipment purchases, and growth opportunities. The Regional Rise Fund reflects ACF's commitment to leveraging philanthropy in innovative ways that create long-term economic resilience and community impact across the Roaring Fork and Colorado River valleys, while also laying the groundwork for future impact investing initiatives, including exploration of a second opportunity focused on affordable housing solutions across the region.

Ultimate Ski Pass



Aspen Skiing Company (ASC) is driven by a mission to connect nature, culture, and recreation while building a more sustainable and resilient future. In addition to delivering world-class mountain experiences across the Rocky Mountains, ASC is deeply committed to addressing climate change and strengthening the communities that make this region thrive.



As part of that commitment, ASC founded Aspen Community Foundation (ACF) in 1980 to help create a vibrant and sustainable Roaring Fork Valley where all residents have access to the resources and opportunities needed to succeed. Although ACF became an independent community foundation in the mid-1990s, the organizations have remained close partners in advancing the well-being of local communities.



Together, ASC and ACF focus on some of the region's most pressing challenges, including affordable housing, healthcare access, climate resilience, mental health and well-being, and economic equity. These interconnected issues shape quality of life and the long-term vitality of the Roaring Fork and Colorado River Valleys. Through sustained collaboration, ASC and Aspen Community Foundation are working to ensure a stronger, more sustainable future for generations to come.

A cornerstone of this partnership is the **Ultimate Ski Pass Fund**, a unique program that transforms a shared passion for skiing and snowboarding into meaningful philanthropic investment. Through the fund, donors support nonprofit organizations creating measurable impact across Roaring Fork and Colorado River Valley communities.

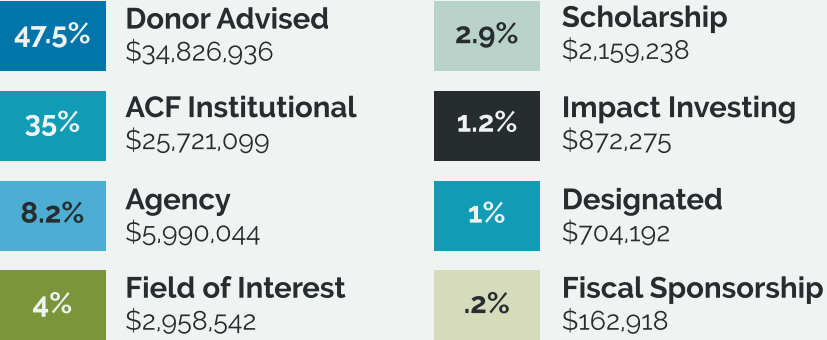

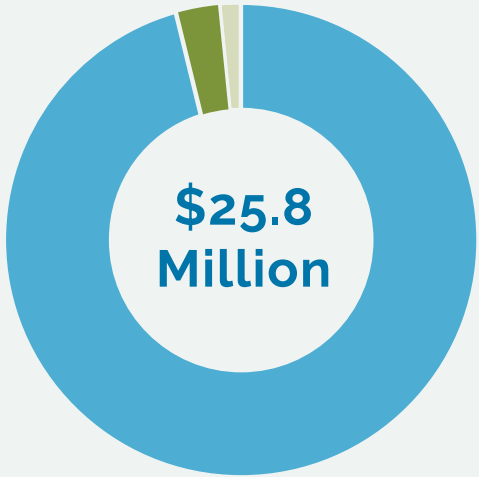
