SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFIERS

- Open to graduating seniors at Aspen, Basalt, Roaring Fork, Bridges, Glenwood Springs, Yampah, Coal Ridge, Rifle or Grand Valley High Schools
- Student must be bicultural and Spanish speaking
- Student must exhibit financial need
- Students should be planning to attend an accredited two-year or four-year college or university and enroll in a minimum of 12 college credits per semester
- Students must aspire to live and work in the greater Roaring Fork Valley after college as a professional counselor, psychologist, psychiatrist, clinical social worker and/or psychiatric nurse.
